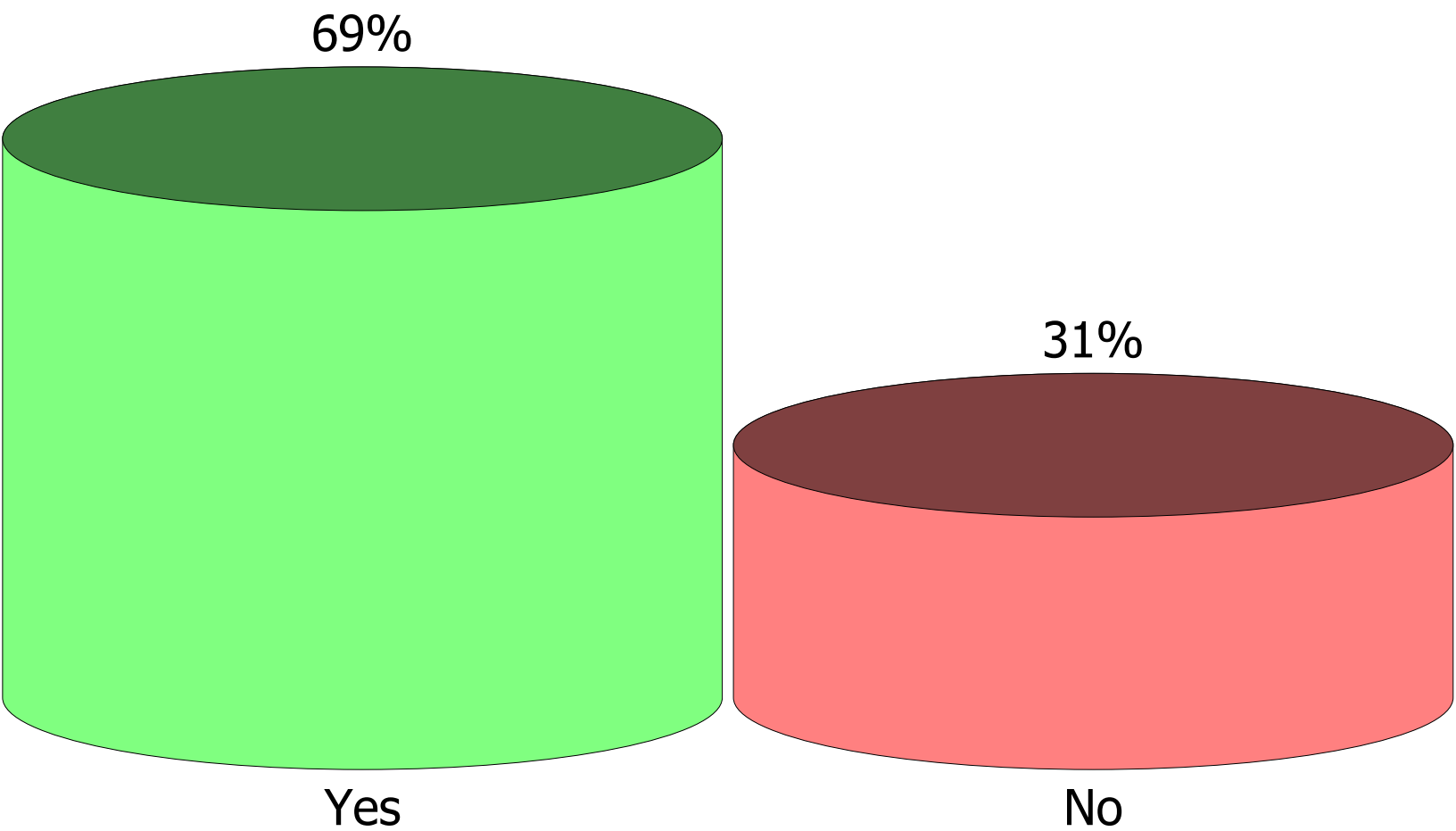

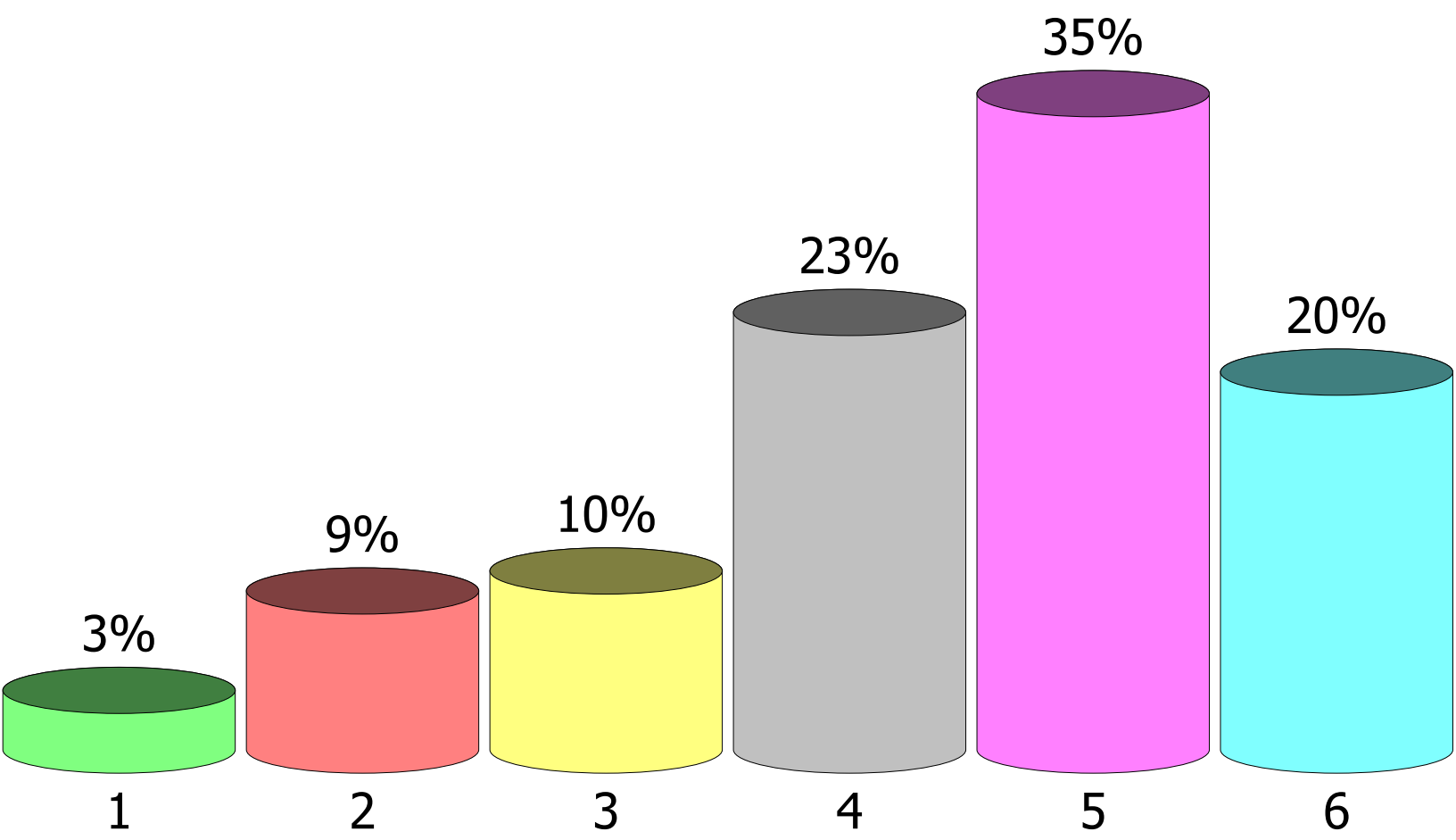
Have you used an audience response system before?

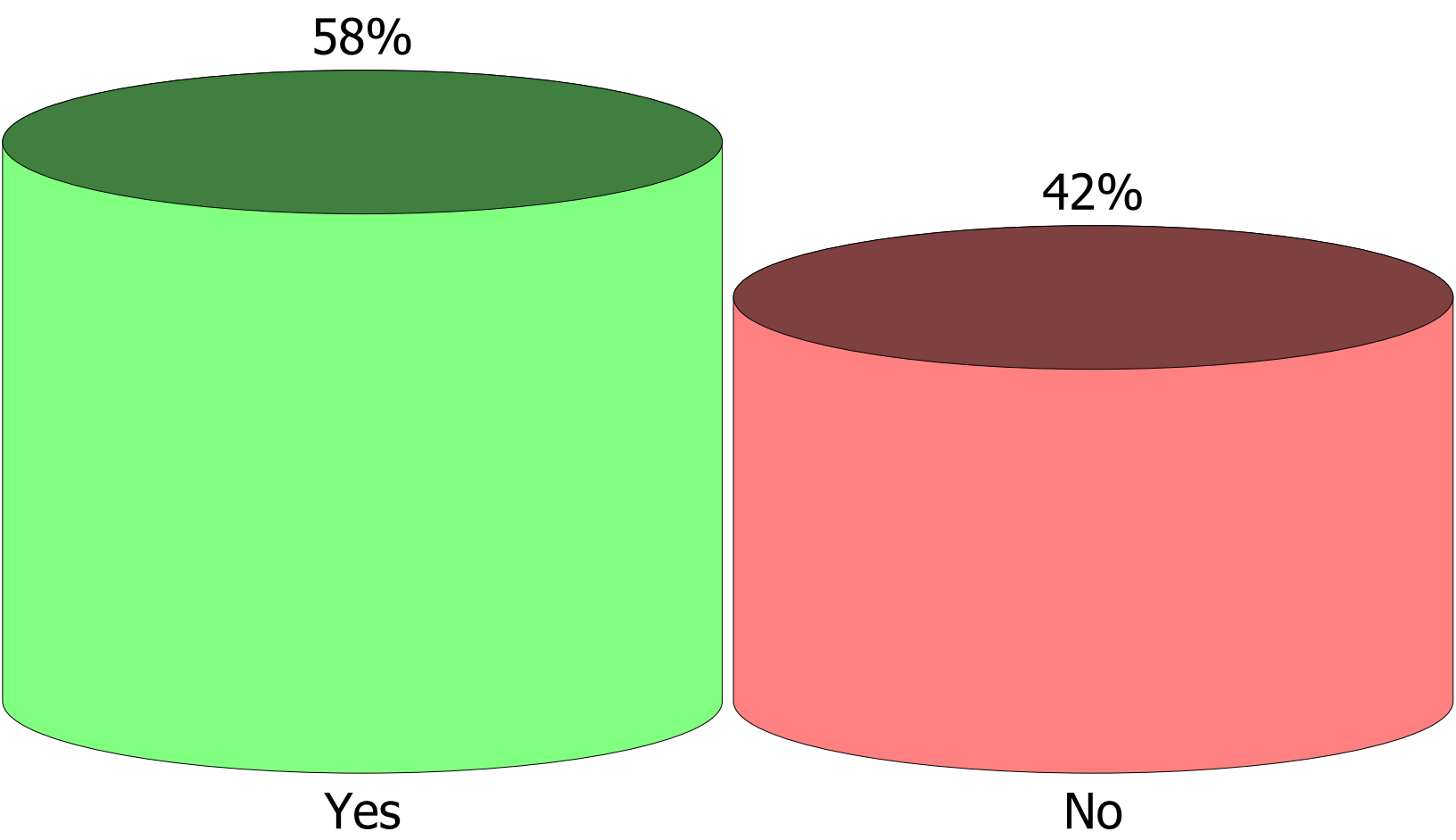
What is your age?

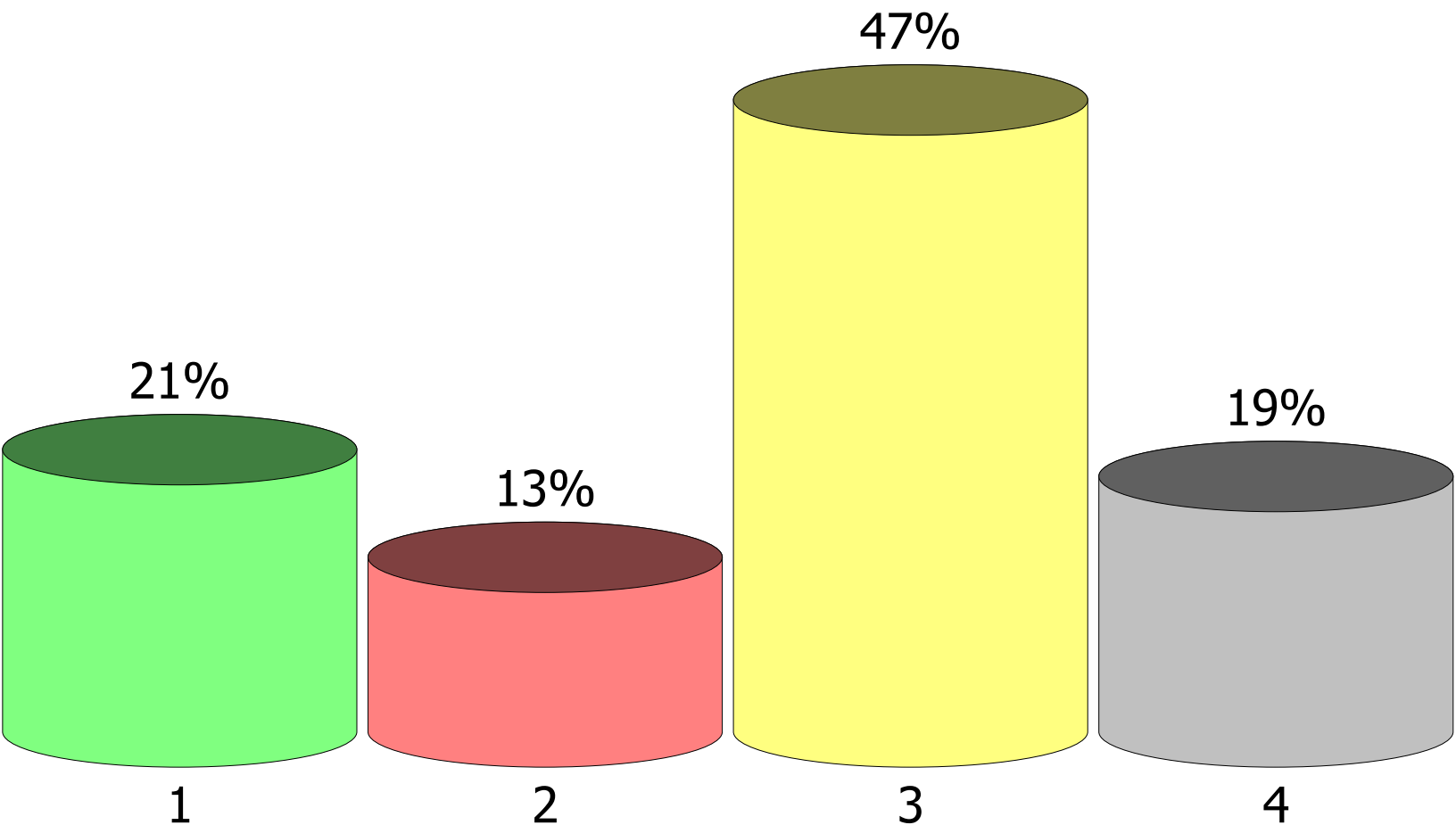
1. Applying successful schools' practices, such as rigorous courses, to improve our schools.

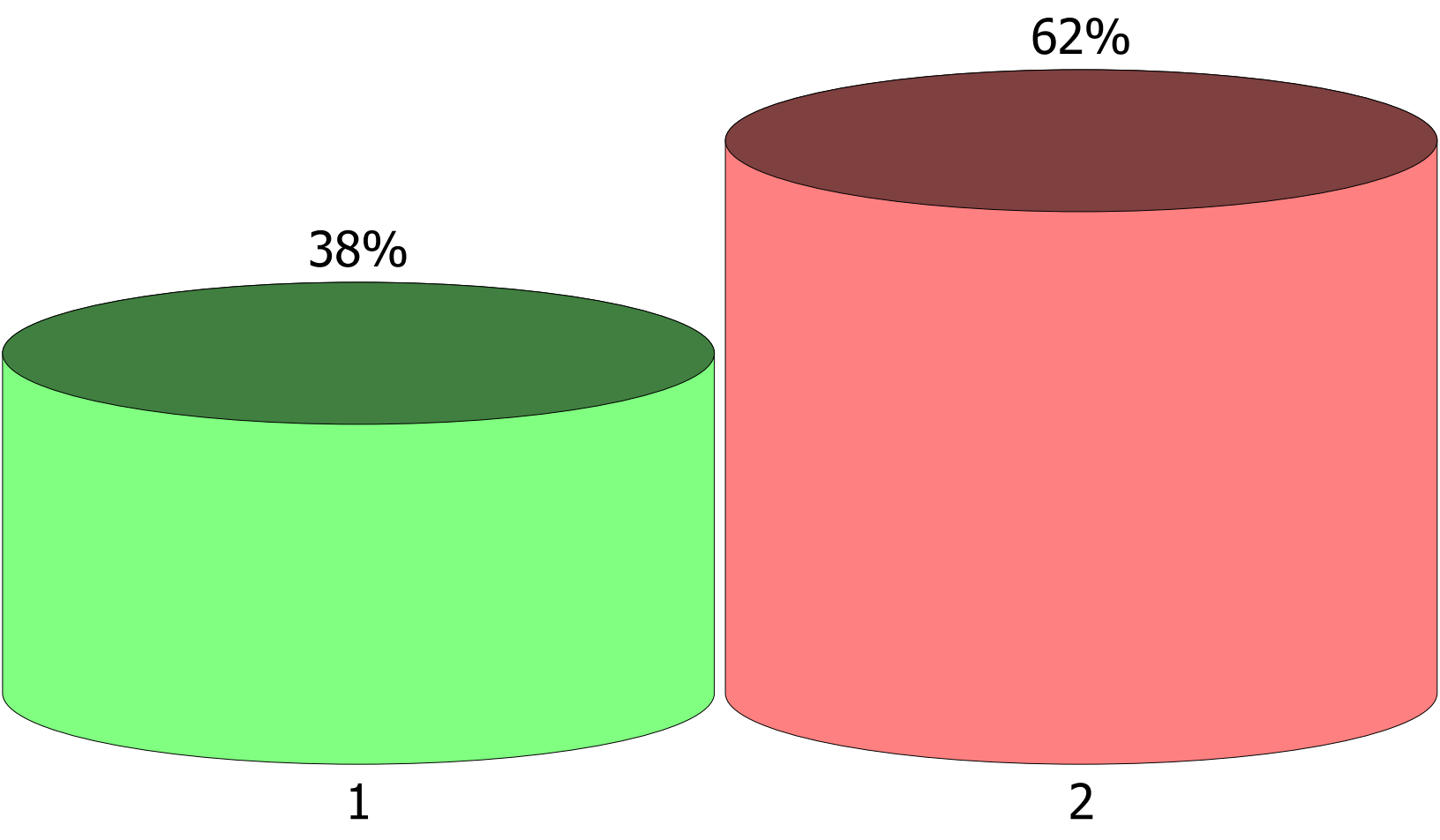
What is your first choice among these topic areas for the discussion today on Housing, Transportation and Infrastructure?

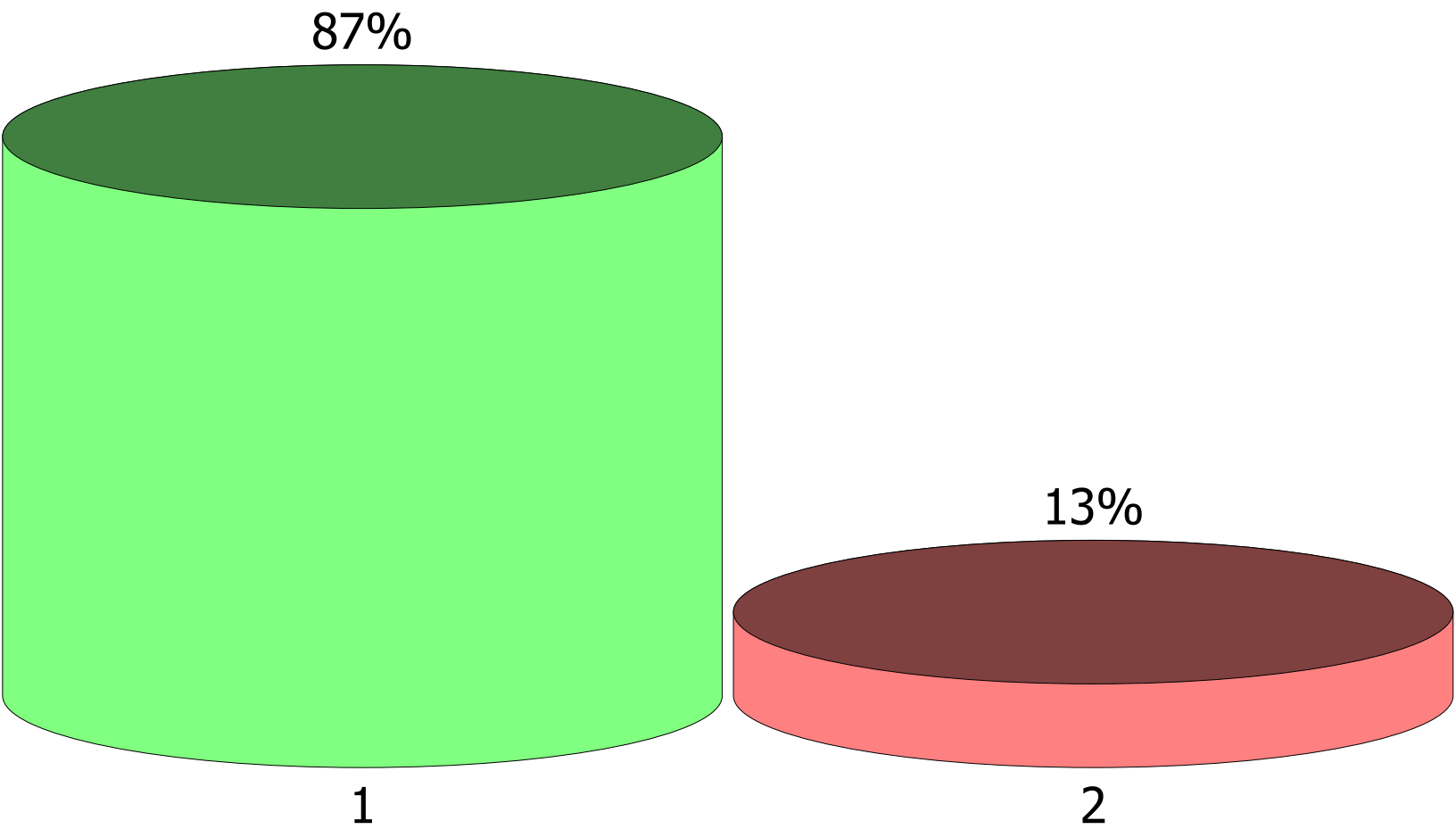

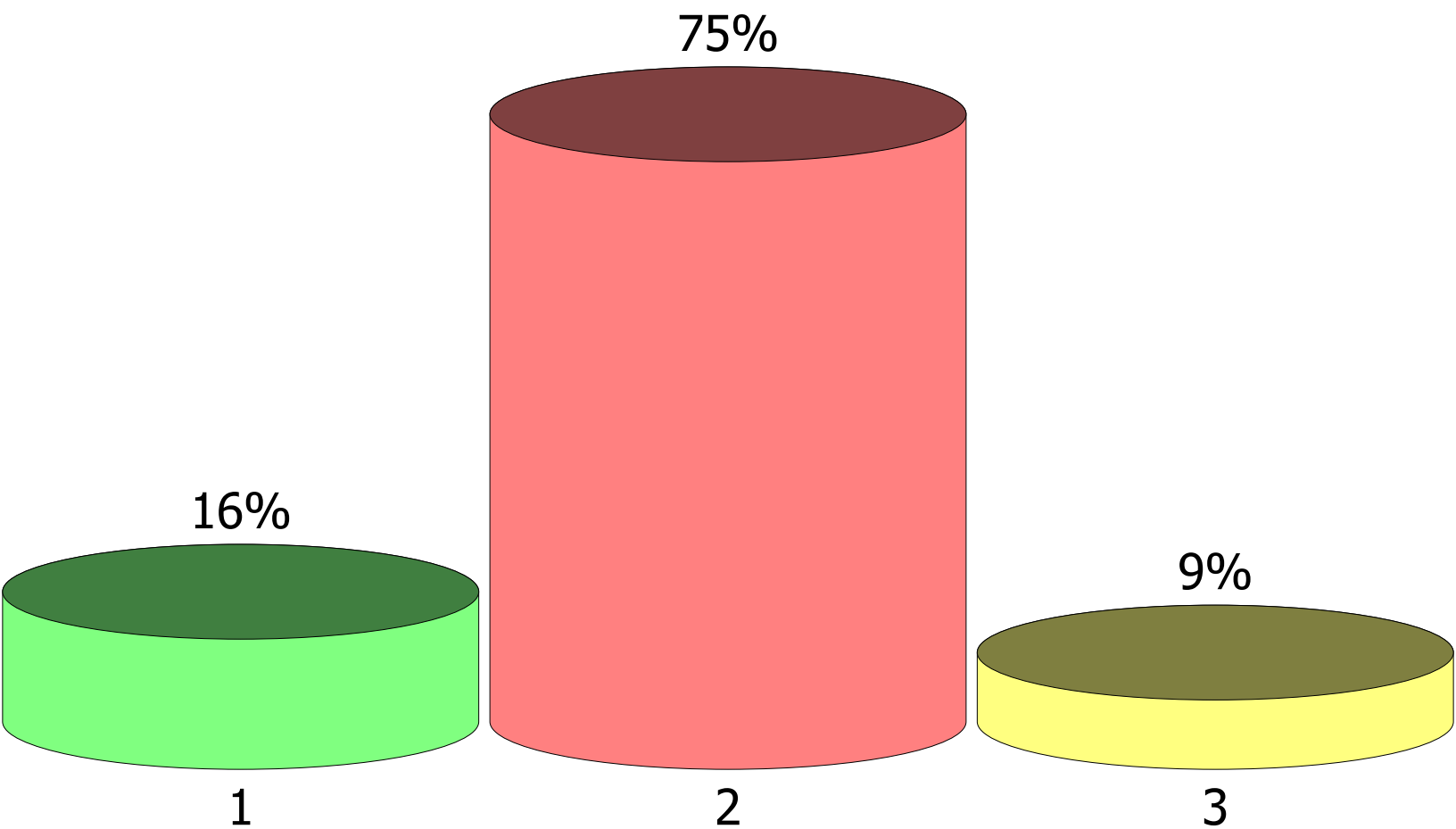

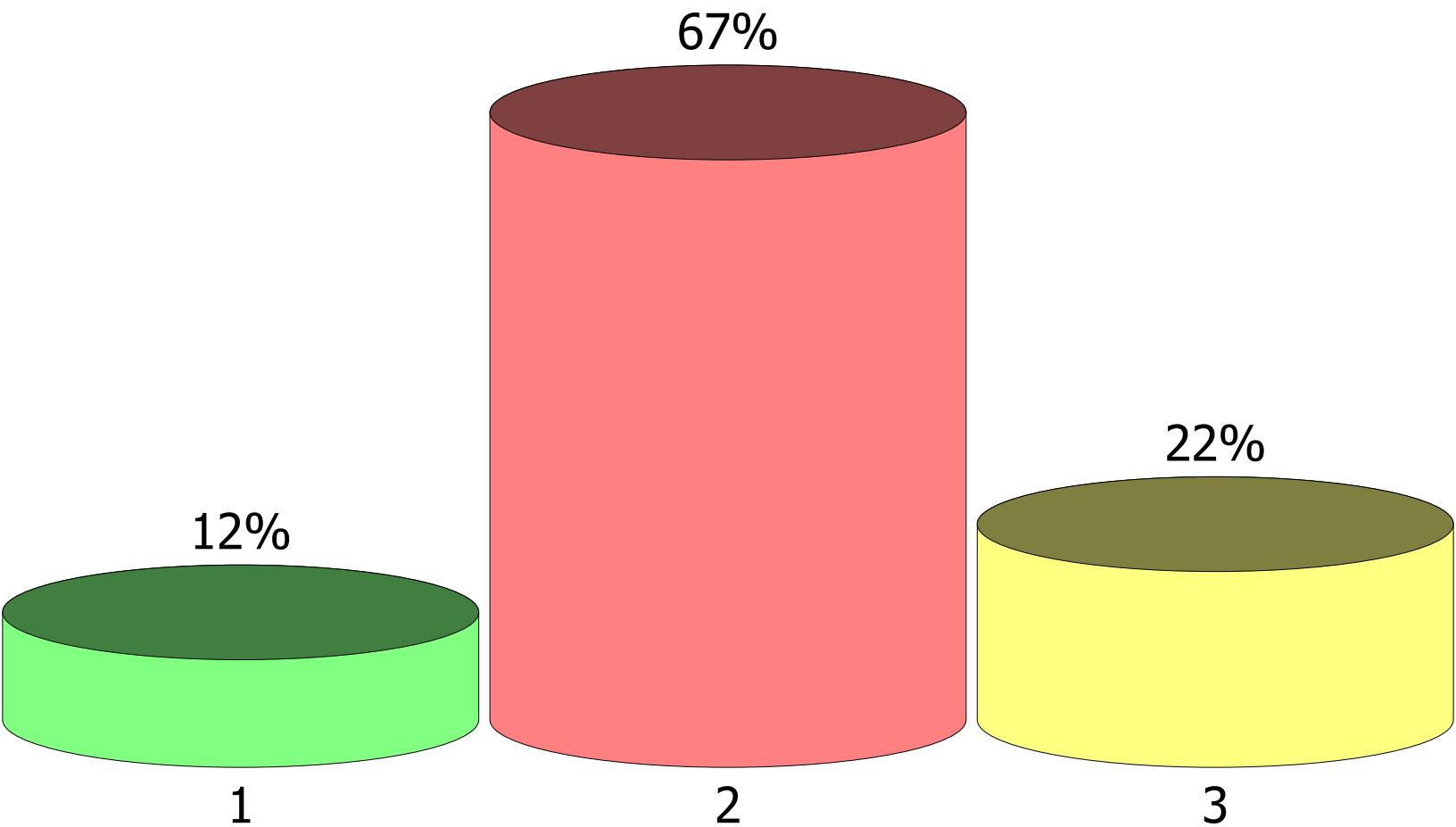
How much Federal funding for housing, transportation, and infrastructure projects do you think there will be in the next 10 years?

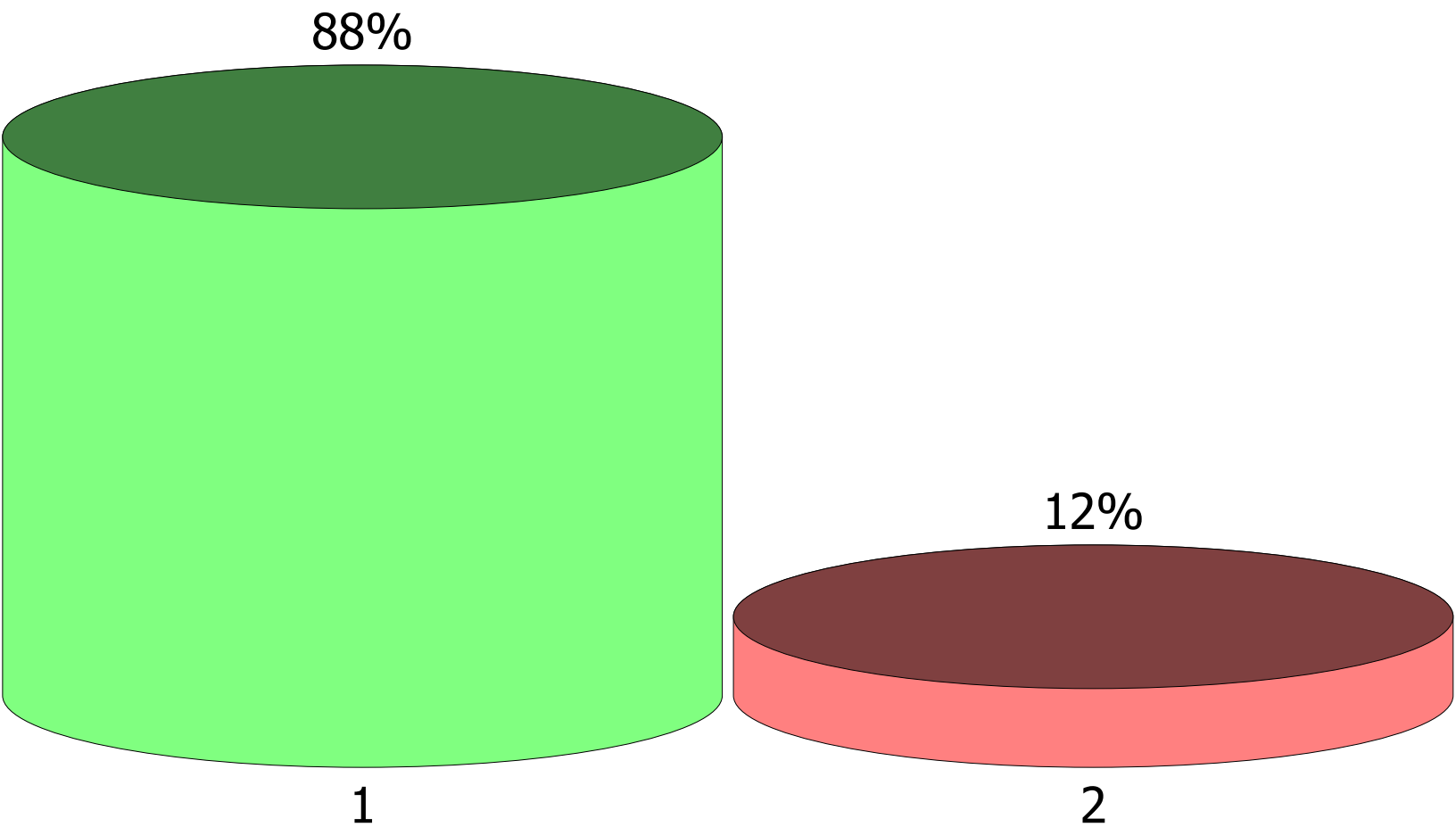

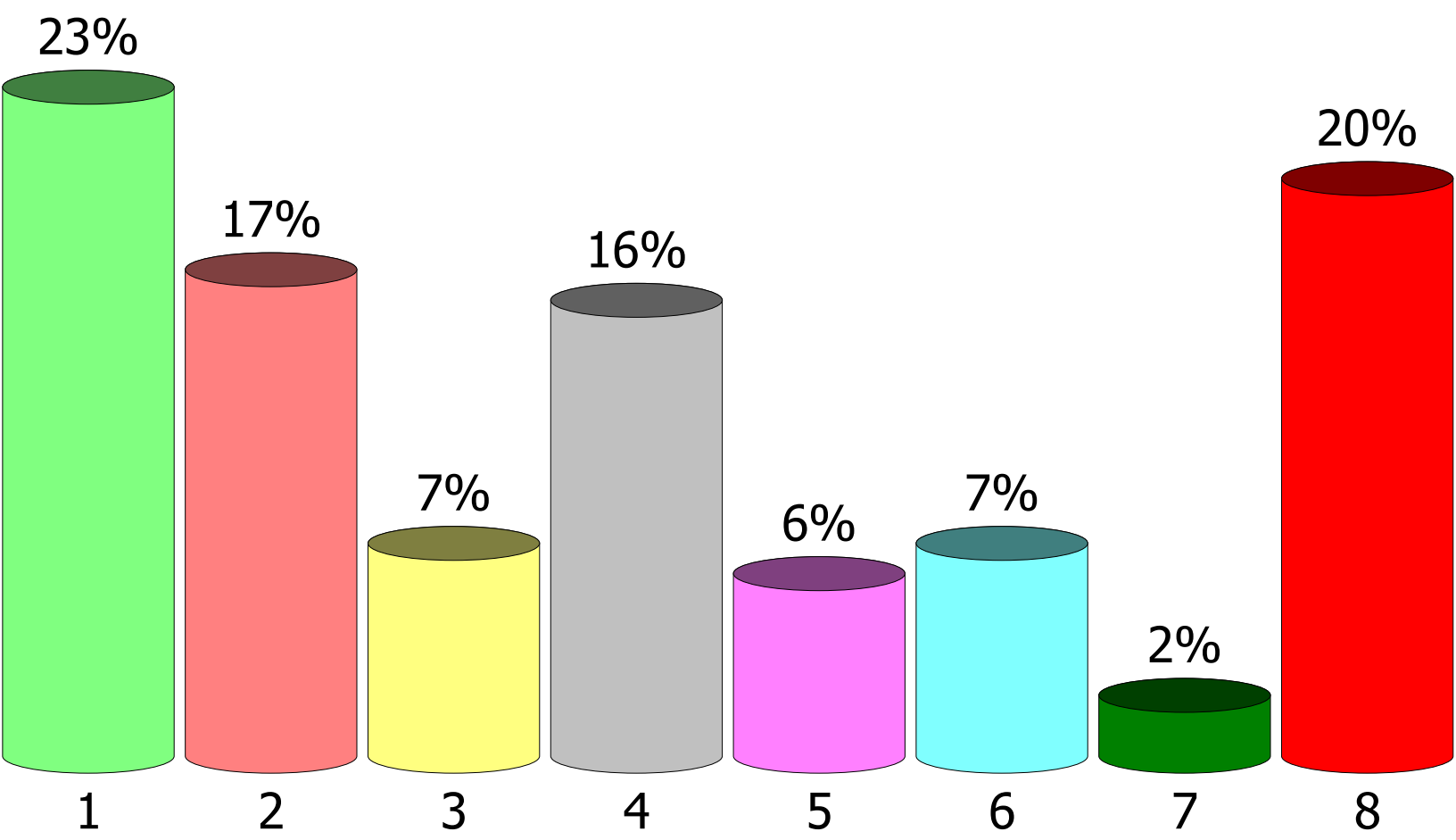

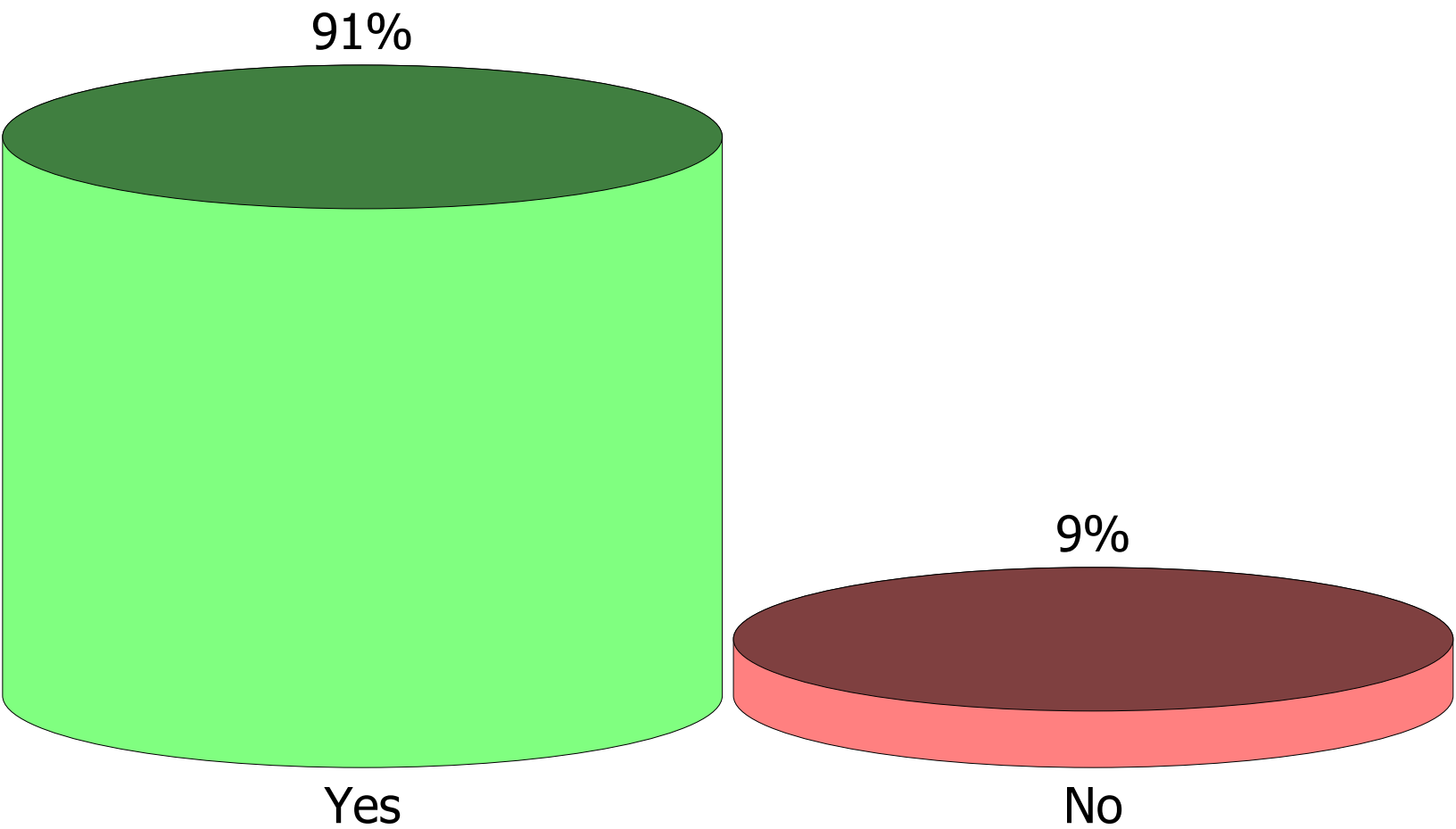

To strengthen the voice of regional residents in fish management, the most important action is to:

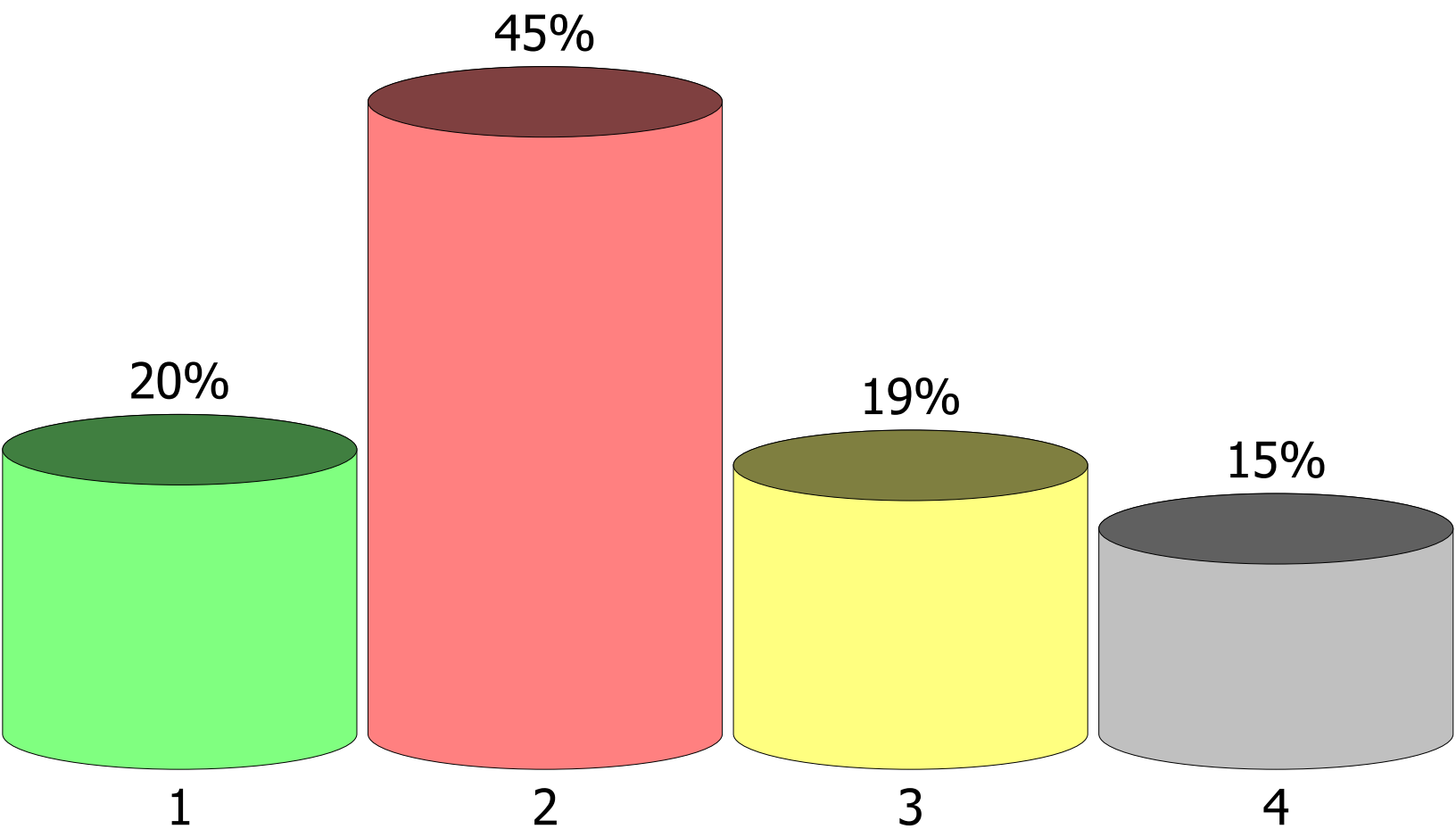
1. Teach local residents about the advisory committee process

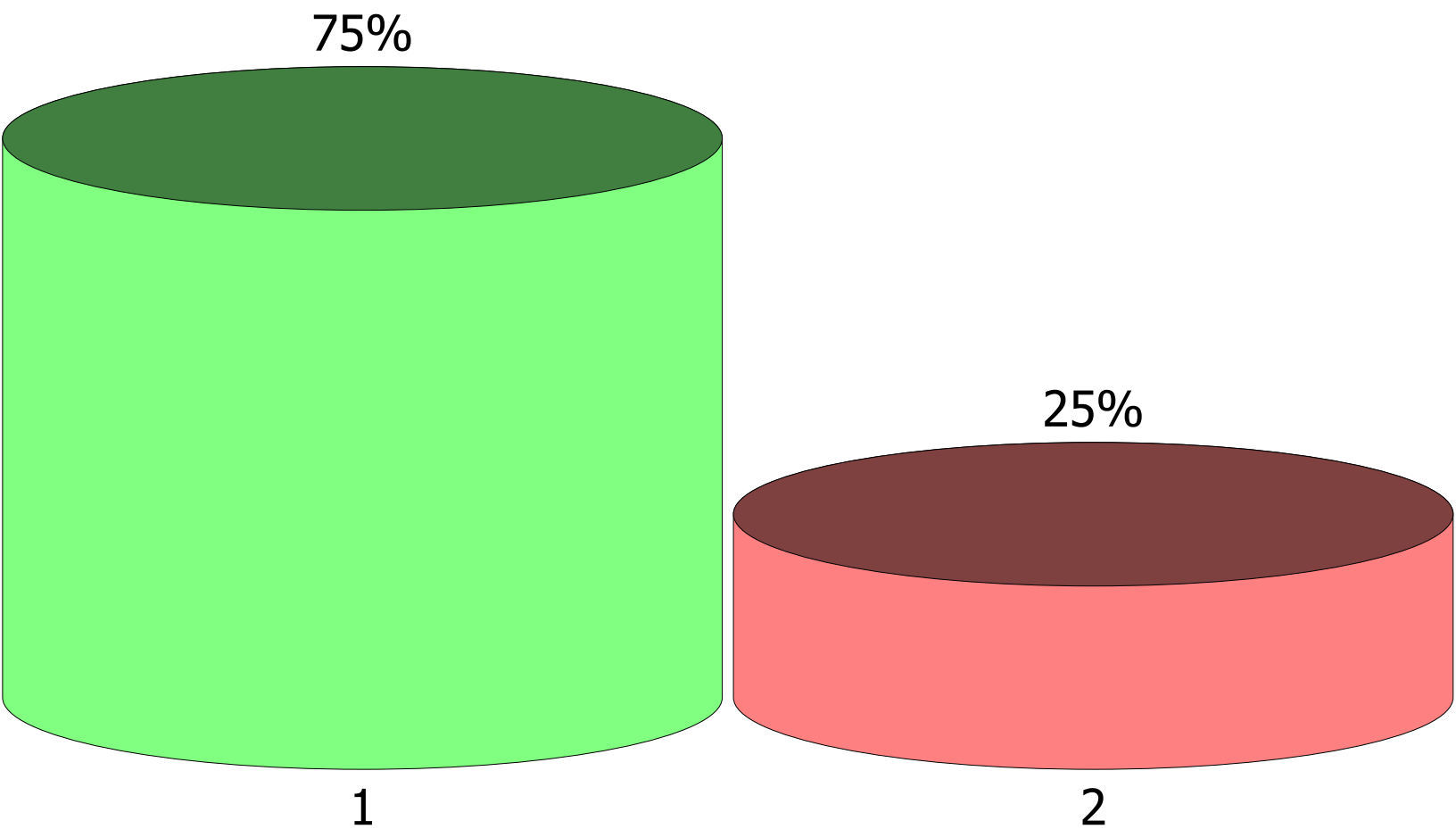
We should increase our scientific database to manage fish and habitat by:

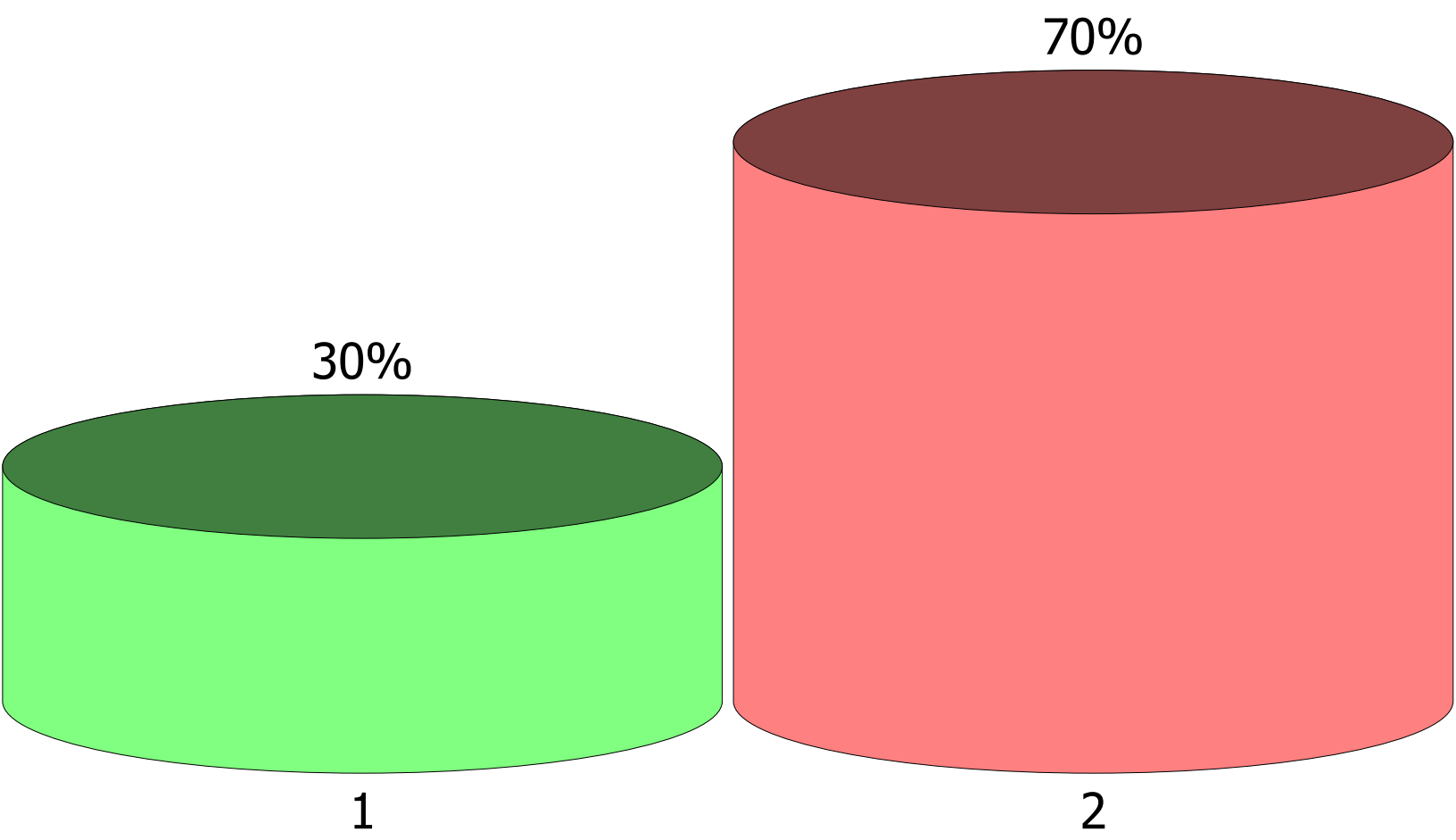

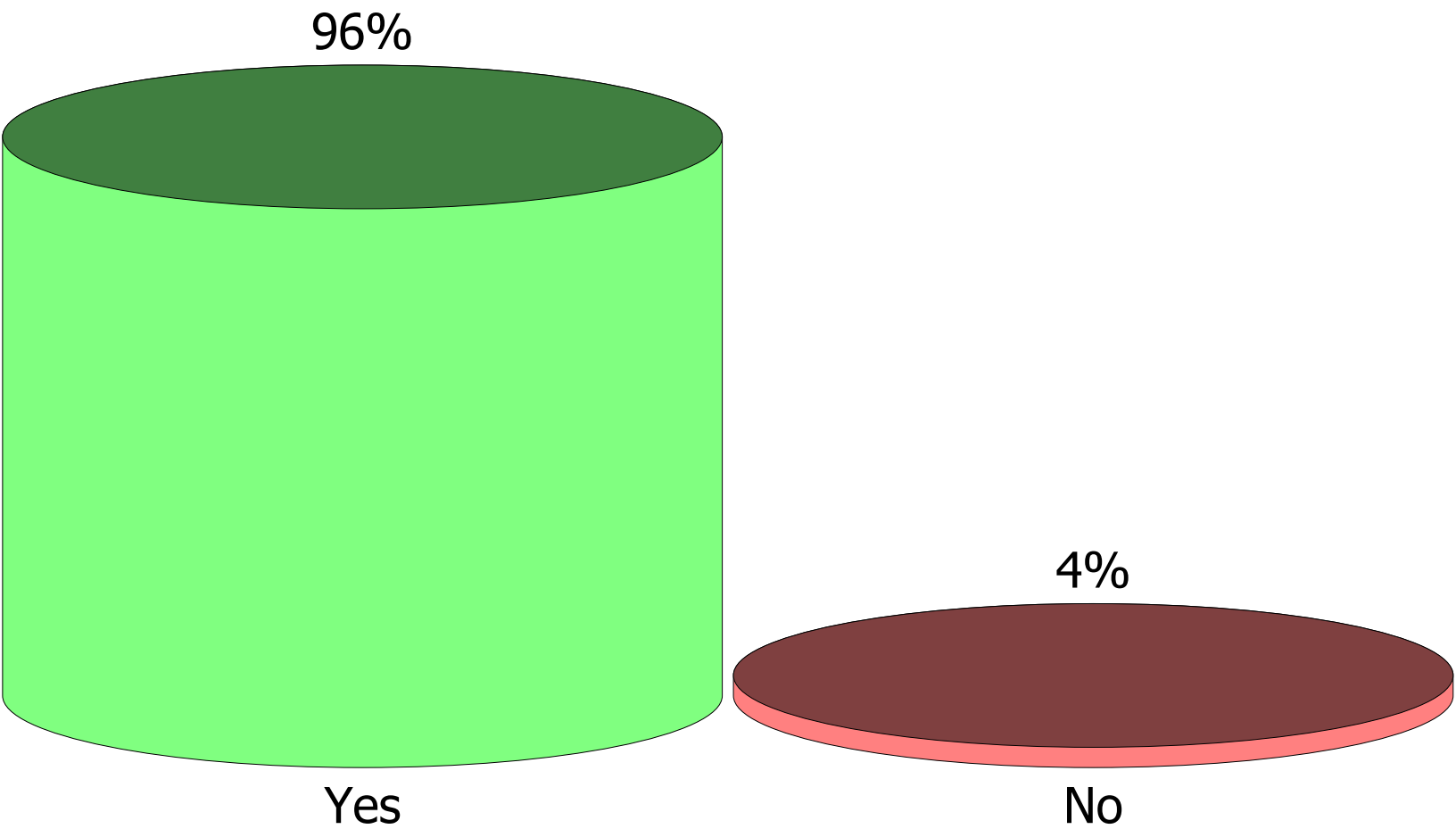

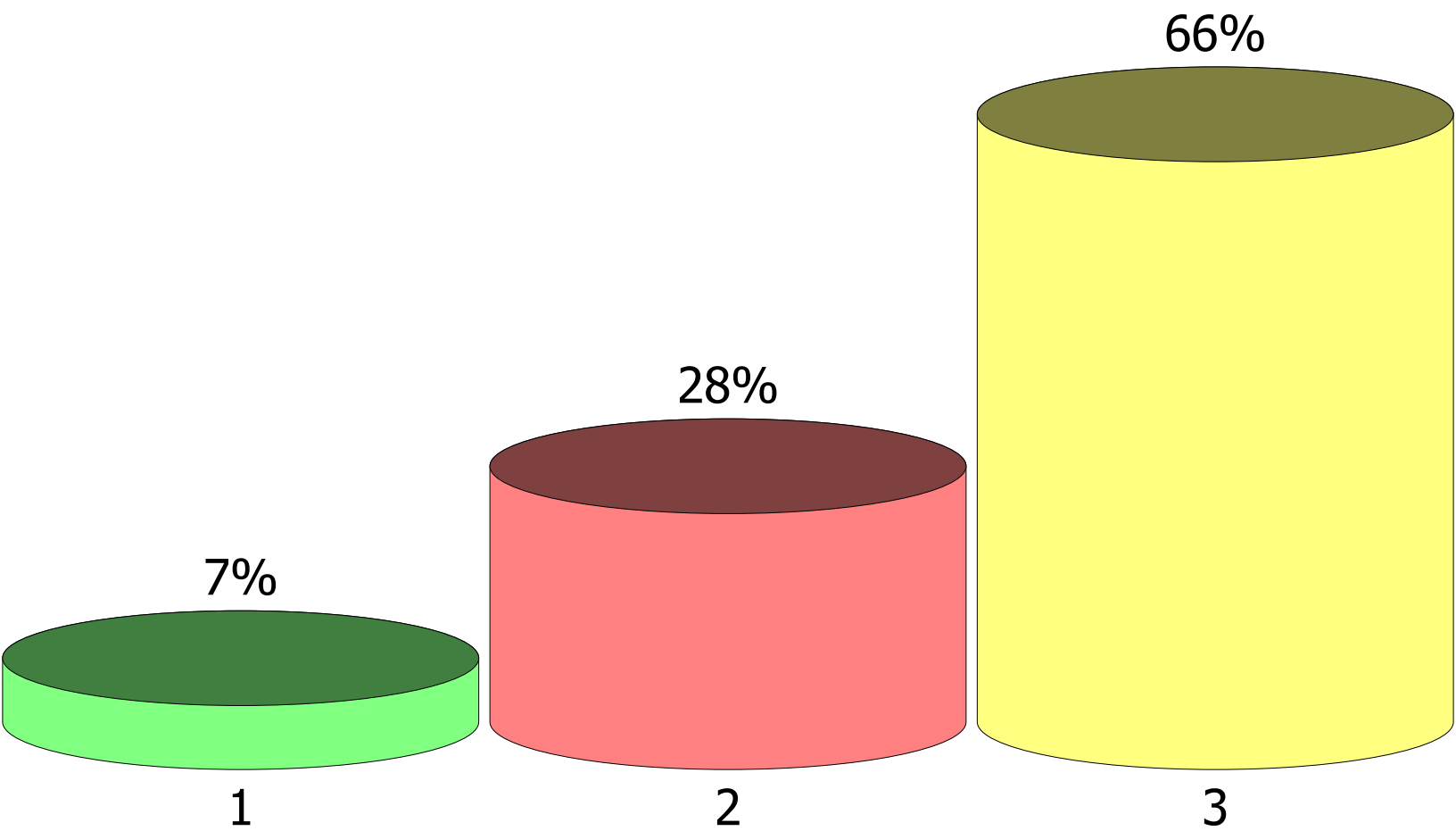
